

Das **simple past** verwendest du, um über Ereignisse oder Handlungen zu sprechen, die in der Vergangenheit stattgefunden haben und abgeschlossen sind.

Du musst bei der Bildung des **simple past** zwischen regelmäßigen Verben und unregelmäßigen Verben unterscheiden.

**simple past** der regelmäßigen Verben:

die Endung **-ed** an den Infinitiv (ohne **to**) anhängen:

z.B. **help + ed** → **helped**

Das **simple past** ist für alle Personen gleich.

häufig verwenden bei Zeitangaben wie:

**last year, yesterday, last month, on my last birthday** usw.

Das **simple past** von „to be“:

nur das Verb „be“ hat im **simple past** zwei Formen

I/He/She/It **was**. (Singular)

We/You/They **were** (Plural)

Die verneinten Formen lauten **wasn't** und **weren't**.

Beim Schreiben muss man auf folgende Besonderheiten achten:

das stumme **-e** am Ende fällt weg:

to **phone**    **phoned**

to **save**      **saved**


Nach kurzem, betontem Vokal wird ein einfacher Endkonsonant verdoppelt:

to **stop**      **stopped**

Verben, die auf Konsonanten **+y** enden, erhalten die Endung **-ied**:

to **try**        **tried**

to **carry**      **carried**

- Last holiday I **shared** (to share) a room with my little sister. It **was** (to be) terrible.
